

Connell F. Smith-Homer Brown Scholarship



Scholarships will be awarded to college students whose parents, grandparents, spouse, or who themselves are a member in good standing with Laborers' Local 773

Applicants must enroll as a full time student for both semesters at a University, College, or Vocational School and must maintain at least a 2.6 cumulative GPA during the entire year to be considered for award

The amount of the award ranges from \$750 to \$2,000 depending on the University or College the applicant will attend

\$750 per year for two year Junior College
\$1,500 per year for a four year University or College
\$2,000 per year for students who attend Southern Illinois University-Carbondale, University of Missouri-Columbia, or University of Missouri Kansas City

Applicants must have all forms, documentation, and essay postmarked no later than May 30th 2017 in order to be considered for the award

Applicants must reapply each year and supply all documentation by the said date

Applicants can not receive an award for more than 4 years (consecutive or non-consecutive)

Applicants who receive a scholarship must volunteer at least one day each year and participate in fundraising efforts or other Union business required by the Local Union Business Manager

Applicants must be in attendance at the August 6th, 2017 Award Ceremony at John A Logan College at 2:30pm in order to receive their award.
