

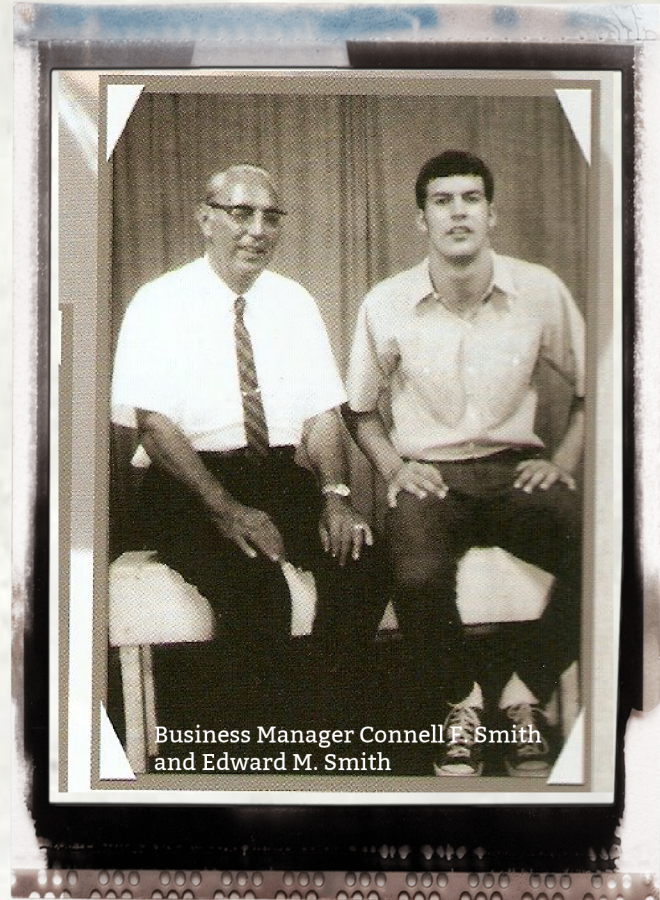
About the Connell F. Smith Homer Brown Scholarship

Connell F. Smith

The Connell F. Smith- Homer Brown Scholarship Fund was established in 1986 to provide members and their families with the opportunity to further their education and obtain a college degree. For more than 30 years, Local 773 has awarded 644 individual scholarships to deserving college students. This award is based on the applicant's demonstrated academic excellence and cumulative grade point average, community involvement, financial needs of the recipients and the promise of continued growth.

Connell F. Smith served as Business Manager/Secretary Treasurer of Laborers' Local 773 from 1942 to 1976. It was his vision and leadership that guides Local 773 to this day in organizing, political action and service to our members and our community.

Homer Brown was a construction laborer during the great depression while serving as sergeant at arms, executive board and Vice President of Laborers' Local 773. His income as a laborer was 55 cents an hour and despite his hardship Brown and his wife Mary managed to make certain their 6 children obtained the highest education possible by attending colleges and serving in the military leading productive and successful lives.
