## **OUR STORY**

Laborers' Local 773 is as diverse as the working men and women who come to embody its most cherished principles of strength, pride and justice. Local 773 was born during a time of conflicts and restraints of the American worker as industries flourished, union members struggled against unsafe working conditions and unfair wages. But in spite of the hardships, Laborers' Local 773 would rise from its most humble beginnings to one of the largest, most diverse and influential Locals in the International.

Local 773 Union Laborers' Cairo, Illinois



On March 11th, 1940, Connell F. Smith was given the charter for Laborers' Local 773 in Cairo, Illinois. And by the 1970's and early 1980's Local 773 extended our representation to workers of public and private industries including employees of government and municipal work, healthcare, railroad maintenance, bus drivers, food service, universities, printers, industrial employees, administrative, and school employees.



Connell F. Smith served as Business Manager and Secretary Treasurer of Laborers' Local 773 from 1940 to 1976. It was his vision that guides Local 773 to this day in organizing, political action and service to the membership. He provided a strong foundation for one of the most respected Local Unions in the entire International Union. His philosophy of "Who can I help today" guided him as the longest serving business manager in Local 773 history. Mr. Smith is best remembered for the deep; abiding respect he had, not only for the hard working union members he represented, but for all working people.

As the turn of the century dawned, the need for more uniform cooperation between the local unions emerged. Local 1274 in Springfield, Illinois merged with Local 773 making it the only Local union in LIUNA to represent members of the railroad construction maintenance. By 2003, eight more LIUNA Locals across Southern Illinois joined Local 773 making it one of the most diverse, extensive and powerful Locals in the International and creating new opportunities for its members. Laborers' Local 773 is now the 12th largest Local Union in the International providing service to our members for over 80 years.





## WHO WE ARE









For over 80 years, Local 773 has worked hard for working men and women. Local 773 includes over 4,000 members who work for public or private employers in Illinois and Missouri, in the railroad maintenance industry across the nation, and as construction craft laborers in Illinois' southernmost 13 counties. Every member soon learns the value of working together for the shared goals of providing and protecting our rights at work. Our members work in construction, government, manufacturing, education, healthcare, law enforcement and many other types of work. We are diverse and proud of our shared abilities. To match the skills and diversity of our membership, Local 773 provides the best trained, highest skilled, hardest working staff of any local union. Our mission is to improve the lives of our members through improved wages, job security, healthcare, retirement benefits and an overall better quality of life for all members and our families.

#### **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS**



Laborers are protected by a Collective Bargaining Agreement, which is an agreement between your employer and our union on behalf of the members of the Laborers' International. This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions of employment and contains provisions in regards to rate of pay, hours of work and other working conditions which have been negotiatied between union representatives and its negotiationg team.

#### As a Union member you have:

The right to representation and negotiations between the Union and your employer with regards to working conditions, healthcare, pension, wages, and other benefits available to members who belong to Laborers' Local 773.

The right to join a union and petition others to join a union

The right to a grievance process when there is a violation of the contract, unfair treatment or violation of the law

The right to have job security and representation during a disciplinary act

The right to safe, healthy and fair working conditions

#### WHO HAVE WE HELPED TODAY



The Connell F. Smith-Homer Brown Scholarship is awarded to college students whose parents, grandparents, spouse, or who themselves are members in good standing with Laborers' Local 773. The Award was established in 1986 to honor the first Business Manager of Local 773, Connell F. Smith who served Local 773 from 1942 to 1976. His philosophy of "Who can I help today" guided him as the longest serving business manager in Local 773 History. The award also honors Homer Brown who was a member of Local 773 during the great depression. He worked as a Laborer for 55 cents an hour while raising five children. Despite his hardships, Brown and his wife Mary made certain their children obtained their education and lead productive, successful lives.

In 2001, delegates elected Terry O'Sullivan, General President and Armand Sabitoni General Secretary Treasurer to serve LIUNA. The International Union and all affiliates operate under the LIUNA Constitution. A great deal of work is carried out through the International Union including representation of the membership at Capitol Hill and overseeing and supporting programs on both regional and local levels.

The LIUNA Midwest Region is located in Springfield, Illinois and is the center for

resources and assistance to 7 District Councils throughout the Midwest while representing more than 55,000 members accross 10 states.

The Southern and Central Illinois Laborers' District Council (SCILDC) is responsible for providing support and oversight of provisions for 5 affiliated Locals. The LIUNA members of Local 773 are represented on the job by the Local Union Business Manager with the assistance of field representives and staff. Business Managers of the Local Unions are elected by you, the Union Member-as are the officers of your Local Union Executive Board.
